

The Hatfield family loses one of its matriarchs

Lillian Lilly Scott Hatfield, 73, died on March 10, 1990 after a short illness in Columbus, Ohio. She became a member of the Hatfield family on December 4, 1935 as she married Guy White Hatfield. Dovel Scott, Aunt Lilly's brother, married Katherine Langley Hatfield four months later.



The Igacu Falls, over two miles wide with numerous cataracts averaging 200 feet in height, is located on the border between Brazil and Argentina. Cusco is located in the high altitude country in the Andes.




Machu Picchu, the lost city of the Inca's, captured by the Morgans in Peru.

Hatfields instrumental in major AT&T project

What do Bon Jovi, Corvettes, and Monday Night Football have in common? An AT&T system that allows television viewers to participate by calling a 900 number to vote for a choice or to enter a lottery for a prize. The new automated voice response system is capable of handling 6,000 calls per minute. The Bon Jovi (a rock band) offered a chance to accompany them on a Russian tour and received over 750,000 telephone calls.

Joy Kay Hatfield and T.J. Hatfield were instrumental in the production and installation of a \$12 million system in time for the Twenty-fifth Anniversary of Monday Night Football. Frank Gifford explained at each half-time how that you could vote for the most spectacular play over the history of Monday Night Football in the series of plays shown on that particular night.

Joy Kay, who has been with AT&T for thirteen years, was the coordinator among the system
